I also want to thank you for the clipping of the editorial from the Journal of the A.M.A. relative to irradiated ergosterol. I noticed the results obtained by these investigators some time ago, and I am starting a rather elaborate series of experiments acting on their data. Experiments now completed have not borne out their conclusions. I fed doses ten times as large as those reported without any harmful results. Yet these experiments may not have covered the field sufficiently; for instance, it is possible that with a higher intake of calcium the effect of ergosterol might become accentuated. It is from this standpoint that the planned experiments will be initiated. If the data submitted by Kreitmair and Moll are correct within the limitations of their experiments, I am, nevertheless, convinced that they will have no practical bearing, because the toxic dose is so much larger than the therapeutic.
